A busy season for everyone

**E**LECTIONS ARE OVER and the newly elected township officials will soon be taking office. It certainly is a busy time for everyone involved in township government which includes the TOIRMA program.

On May 4, 2009, we will be mailing the Supervisor's/Treasurer's Bond Application to the designated township contact. This mailing will allow the application to be completed and signed by the appropriate individuals and returned to TOIRMA. The township will then have fulfilled the requirements as prescribed by law.

It is important for all elected members of the township to ensure this is completed and returned. While some contacts have retired voluntarily, some have not and therefore the forwarding of the application to the correct person may become an issue. The interest and due diligence of the other elected officials to assist in making sure the township is in compliance and coverage is in place to protect the township may be necessary.

Along the same subject, the renewal billings were mailed on April 17, 2009 to the designated contact. The payment is due on or before June 1, 2009 and we do occasionally have the same problem with these statements as with the above mentioned Bond Appli-

cation. Assistance from the other elected officials in this matter is also greatly appreciated by TOIRMA and will allow the coverage provided by TOIRMA to continue without interruption.

On May 31, 2009, TOIRMA will have completed 23 years of significant involvement with townships in Illinois. We anticipate 100 percent renewal and when that is completed, it will be the 11th consecutive year that goal has been achieved. As evidenced by the dividend check pictures printed in the Perspective, TOIRMA has worked diligently to serve and protect our members from the first day of business and has been able to return a dividend in the process. I trust that return will always be possible.

As an additional reminder, the "VOID WITHIN 60 DAYS FROM ISSUE DATE" on the dividend checks is rapidly approaching. If your township's dividend check has not been deposited in the appropriate account, please do so quickly to meet that deadline.

TOIRMA will be represented at each of the remaining TOI education meetings around the state. We hope to see you there and will be available to provide assistance or answer your questions.
