MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON TOWNSHIP MONDAY, JANUARY 25, 2016

The Board of Trustees for the Town of the City of Bloomington Township met in the Council Chambers of the City Hall Building at 6:30 p.m. on January 25, 2016.

The meeting was called to order by Trustee Renner and the following were present:

Trustees: Kevin Lower, David Sage, Mboka Mwilambwe, Karen Schmidt, Scott Black, Diana Hauman, Amelia Buragas, Jim Fruin, Joni Painter and Tari Renner.

Staff present: Cherry L. Lawson, Township Clerk; Steve Scudder, Township Assessor and Deborah Skillrud, Township Supervisor.

Approval of the Minutes of December 21, 2015 Board Meeting, as submitted by Cherry Lawson, Town Clerk.

Motion by Trustee Black, seconded by Trustee Painter, that the Minutes of December 21, 2015 meeting be approved as presented.

Motion carried, (viva voce).

Action and Approval of the Board on Monthly General Town Fund, General Assistance Fund and Evergreen Memorial Cemetery Audits of December 2015 accounts.

Motion by Trustee Black, seconded by Trustee Painter, that the General Town Fund, General Assistance Fund, and Evergreen Memorial Cemetery Audits for the month of December 2015 be approved as presented.

Ayes: Trustees Sage, Lower, Mwilambwe, Schmidt, Black, Hauman, Buragas, Fruin, Painter and Renner.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

Approval of the General Town Fund anticipated expenditures as presented and certified.

Motion by Trustee Black, seconded by Trustee Painter, that the General Town Fund anticipated expenditures be approved as presented.

Ayes: Trustees Sage, Lower, Mwilambwe, Schmidt, Black, Hauman, Buragas, Fruin, Painter and Renner.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

Deborah Skillrud, Township Supervisor, addressed the Board. She provided an update as the Ecology Action Center's recycling pots program needed a new location. She thanked John Brandt for his efforts searching for a new location. The Ecology Action Center does not have liability insurance for a building. It is researching cost to attain same.

Ms. Skillrud also reported that the Illinois Department of Employment Security, (IDES), will be closing its doors this spring. This would affect General Assistance. Action is being taken to locate the right IDES staff person for determination of General Assistance eligibility. There is an IDES office in Peoria. This might be option but a point of contact regarding information was needed.

Trustee Black questioned if it was the state's decision to close the office. Ms. Skillrud responded affirmatively. The City Township was not involved in the decision. Jeff Mays, IDES Director, would be speaking at McLean County Chamber of Commerce's Breakfast Business Briefs on Friday, January 29, 2016. She hoped to speak with him at the meeting.

Ms. Skillrud informed the Board that the preliminary budget for fiscal year 2017 would be presented at the Board's February 22, 2016 meeting.

Trustee Schmidt commented on balancing the City's Rental Inspection Program with the Township's General Assistance Program. She questioned if the Township benefitted from the Rental Inspection Program. Ms. Skillrud noted General Assistance Program's strict regulations, (60 ILCS), which defines client eligibility. The definition section does not addressed landlord in terms of quality of residence. Unfortunately, there was substandard housing in the City. It was a balancing act: trying to find a location that a client would not be evicted from. Township's monthly grant is \$265 a month. This amount provided little assistance towards rent. This amount was \$20 higher than state statute required. This amount does not cover rent for a decent, affordable apartment. The result can be substandard housing. The Township has no authority. There is a landlord's statement: receipt of township funds meant that a client could not be evicted or proceedings for same could not commence during the month assistance was received.

Trustee Sage noted a change in the activity report. Formerly reports provided year-to-year comparisons. Ms. Skillrud planned to publish this information at year end. She offered to revisit this decision. She planned to provide the information in the next report.

Steve Scudder, Township Assessor, addressed the Board. January 1, 2016 started the 2016 assessment year. All properties in the City would be evaluated for real estate tax purposes. There were 916 Residential Permits issued, seventy-seven (77) of these were for new, single family homes. New construction was expected to surpass this number by March 2016. There are 365 Commercial Permits issued, few additions to new properties were expected.

The McLean County Supervisor of Assessments held a meeting in December 2015. The Assessor's Office was commended for process speed and continued efforts to maintain deadlines.

The Equalized Assessed Value (EAV) for 2015 was slightly higher than 2014 which increased assessed dollars for the City last year.

Trustee Painter questioned if there were individuals who do not take out building permits and make improvements to their property. Mr. Scudder responded that landowners who obtain permits from the City were offered Home Improvement Exemptions if same increased the property's value. If a permit is not obtained, the exemption could be waived. Some are brought to the Assessor's Office attention and others have been discovered when Assessor's staff was out in the community performing assessment work.

Trustee Renner opened the meeting to receive Public Comment. No one came forward to address the Board.

Motion by Trustee Schmidt, seconded by Trustee Hauman, to adjourn. Time: 6:42 p.m. Motion carried (viva voce).

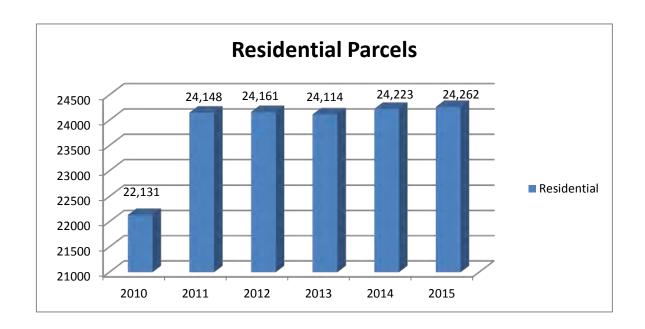

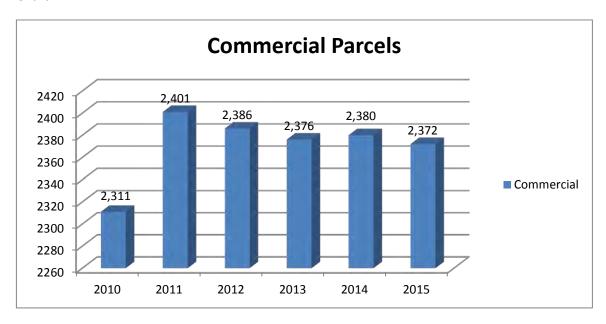
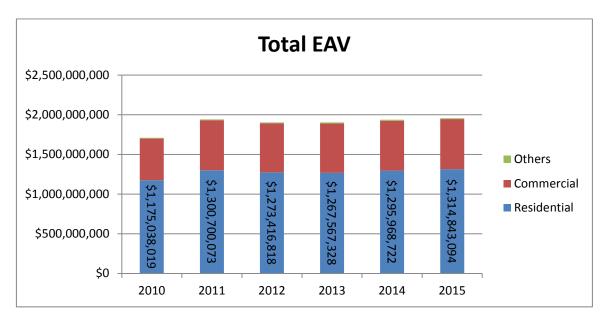
