## ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION – There is a meeting next month, no correspondence, no report at this time.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Von Bergen reported getting 2019 numbers from the County & will update the values on the farm land changes, senior freeze forms are out & are needed every year, senior homestead exemption form does not require to reapply every year. Have had many meetings & will attend a farm land assessment meeting tomorrow with the Farm Bureau.

TRUSTEES – Trustee Von Bergen reported the solar farm east of town with not be perused, the cost to run lines to the substation will be too much, approximately 7.2 million. Not sure about the one south of town but the distance is similar to the nearest substation. Storm Water Management meet at the Farm Bureau on redoing the ordinance with the County. Reed reported some poling location changes due to COVID-19 precautions, none of the changes in the Hebron precincts.

ROAD COMMISSIONER – Commission Nickels reported plowing, salting, picking up trash, brush, patching, working on equipment, section on Vander Karr Rd will be dug out in the next week. New truck problem was located & fixed.

SUPERVISOR: CEMETERY – 0 burial, 0 staking fee & 0 grave sales. Continue to input into database & working on cataloging this spring, next meeting is in April. GREEN STREET – 1 payment received. GA – 2 inquiries, 1 pending application, reviewed GA amounts & increased emergency assistance to up to \$200 and \$50 additional for each dependent. ADMINISTRATION/BUILDING – received correspondence from Sinagrow to apply sludge. There is a bunch of legislation coming thru that might affect recording meetings, publishing vendors of \$1000 & more and also regarding IMRF benefits.
