

# PROCEEDINGS OF A TOWN MEETING

CALL TO ORDER - At the Regular Town Meeting, held in the town of Hebron, County of McHenry, and State of Illinois, at 7:00p.m. on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of September 2019, the meeting was called to order by Nancy Lech, Township Supervisor. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Building Completion Fund Bills – No bills were presented for consideration of the Building Fund.

## ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION – There was no report at this time.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Von Bergen reported assessment notices were mailed and the appeals end October 4<sup>th</sup>.

ROAD COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported mowing ditches, paving, shouldering, working with Greenwood Township, O’Brien Rd is complete and scheduled special garbage pickup on Armory Rd with a nearby neighbor. Sat down with Jack Pease regarding the agreement.

TRUSTEES – Trustee Von Bergen reported the frame for the restored map was completed by Tom Behles.

SUPERVISOR: CEMETERY – August: 1 staking fee & no sales, September: no staking fees, no sales. There was discussion on the condition, need to remove the outhouse and the cost to properly remove. The cemetery board had asked for a separate fund to be created just for donations, the township board did not see the need for another account because there is already a cemetery fund and all the funds in that account are only used on the cemetery. A sexton from another cemetery was consulted on the headstone placed on the incorrect plot and cost to move it would be about \$900. GREEN STREET – A payoff quote was requested

\$77,213.84. Money is being put aside for property taxes from the monthly payments. GENERAL ASSISTANCE – August: 1 qualifying for monthly assistance, 1 – pending, called 211 for medical transportation September: 2 qualifying for monthly assistance. ADMISTRATION – Review Annual Financial Report FYE March 31, 2018. Trustee Von Bergen motion to approve the AFR FYE March 31, 2018. Second Trustee Schaid. Roll call vote Ayes – 5: Trustee Maule, Trustee Schaid, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Reed & Trustee Von Bergen. Nays – 0. Motion Passed. Table the AFR FYE March 31, 2019. TOWNSHIP OFFICE BUILDING – Thanks to Trustee Maule & Commissioner Nickels for picking up and hauling the office furniture. There was an explanation of HSB348, to dissolve townships with 15 miles or less. Sidewalk, Supervisor Lech just decided to get it done. CLERK – Supervisor Lech noticed some discrepancies in the meeting dates verse the day of the week they should be held. Trustee Von Bergen motion to correct the meeting dates of the Regular Meeting December 10, 2019 to December 11, 2019 and Cemetery Board Meeting January 24, 2020 to January 23, 2020. Second Trustee Maule. Roll call vote Ayes – 5: Trustee Maule, Trustee Schaid, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Reed & Trustee Von Bergen. Nays – 0. Motion Passed.

OLD BUSINESS – Supervisor Lech meet with engineers from Jim Conlon’s office. Waiting to hear back, they have a guy that could save money on the soil/boring samples.

NEW BUSINESS – Map DVD purchase policy – There are individuals interested in purchasing a copy of the map, there was as discussion on accepting a minimum donation in the amount of \$25 for the rights to the print.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – There is a weight loss competition going on in the community called Hebron’s Biggest Losers. It is being sponsored by many local business, individuals and organizations. \$1 for every pound lost will be donated by one business to the Hebron Food Pantry, another business will be donating \$1 worth of hygiene products to the Hebron Food Pantry for every pound lost, another will donate \$1 for every pound lost to the Alden Hebron Athletics program. The Midwest Nova Kings has already donated \$200 to the Hebron Food Pantry as well.

ADJOURNMENT – Trustee Von Bergen moved to adjourn the meeting. Second Trustee Schaid. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote. The meeting adjourned 7:40pm.
