MINUTES

CAPITAL TOWNSHIP BOARD

JULY 10, 2023

The Capital Township Board of Trustees met in the County Board Chambers, 2nd floor County Building. The board stood for the Pledge of Allegiance. The following members answered to roll call: Joe Aiello, Kelly Gilmore, Ken Leonard, and Tammie Rockford. Trustee Gordon was absent. Joe Roesch and Justin Reichert were present as legal counsel. Mark Crawford was also present.

MINUTES

A motion was made by Trustee Rockford, seconded by Trustee Gilmore, to approve the Minutes of June 12, 2023. A voice vote was unanimous.

A motion was made by Trustee Leonard, seconded by Trustee Rockford, to approve the Minutes of June 26, 2023. Supervisor Aiello stated they need to amend those minutes to remove Brad Carlson’s name from the attendance from this meeting. A motion was made by Trustee Rockford, seconded by Trustee Gilmore, to amend the Minutes of June 26, 2023. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays. There were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays to approve the Minutes, as amended.

ADMINISTRATION EXPENDITURES

A motion was made by Trustee Rockford, seconded by Trustee Leonard, to approve payment of the Supervisor/Collector/General Assistance Administration Expenditures in the amount of \$750.00. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Trustee Gilmore, seconded by Trustee Rockford, to approve payment of the Township Clerk/Township Assessor’s Administration Expenditures in the amount of \$475.94. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.

SUPERVISOR'S UPDATE

Supervisor Aiello discussed the Efficiency Commission and each of the trustees are members of the commission. Supervisor Aiello asked Mike Murphy to serve as a commissioner. Mr. Murphy is with the Chamber of Commerce and was a member of the Sangamon County Efficiency Commission. At some point they will bring in Mr. Murphy and another person from the public to be part of the group. The commission will meet three times between now and December 2024, and they will develop an agenda. There is a variety of things they can work on. Efficiencies in government is one of the things they have done well so far. Years ago, there was an effort to consolidate/eliminate Collectors, and that was done through a referendum. They disbanded that commission. He may look at papers they have written, but this group here will decide what efficiencies they want to engage in and study. They have until 2024 before they make any decisions and recommendations. One of the subjects to review may be assessors. The townships outside of Capital have challenges recruiting Assessors, but Capital Township is fine. He will get Mr. Murphy to be a part of it since he has the experience working on the county commission.

A motion was made by Trustee Rockford, seconded by Trustee Leonard, to adjourn the meeting to August 14, 2023 at Noon. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.
