COMMITTEE REPORTS:

SUPERVISOR'S:

New state law HB3711 went into effect stating a baby changing table must be in every public restroom. One was ordered and installed in the men's restroom in the hall. The women's restroom already had one on the wall.
General Assistance for the month of August 2019 was \$915.00 and Emergency Assistance was \$2434.96 for 7 recipients.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER'S:

Mr., Barton is getting estimates for a concrete floor for wooden structure, slanted roof salt bin 25 feet by 25 feet. He has concrete blocks that will be used also. He is getting estimates from Custom Concrete, Halco's, and Dennis Concrete. First estimate from Custom Concrete was \$6300.00. The other two should be very close to that one. Mr. Barton would like to get this project done this winter if possible. Mr. Christensen suggested that some type of treatment be put on the concrete so that the salt will not cause damage. Mr. Barton will check on this matter with the concrete vendors.

Commissioner Barton then presented to the board the possibly of widening Richards Rd. between Route 23 and Kangley Rd. approximately 2 miles. Widen the road 1- 1 ½ feet to each side would make a big difference since that road is heavily traveled especially semitrucks using it to reroute around Streator. I would like to get estimates on the cost of widening the road which would be a major safety feature. Maybe we could check into bonds for the cost of the project. We may be able and be cost effective if we could build up the sides and use oil and chip instead of asphalt.
His crew is done for the year oil and chipping the township roads.
