MINUTES

CAPITAL TOWNSHIP BOARD

MARCH 13, 2023

The Capital Township Board of Trustees met in the County Board Chambers, 2nd floor County Building. The board stood for the Pledge of Allegiance. The following members answered to roll call: Joe Aiello, Brad Carlson, Bernadette Gordon, Ken Leonard, and Tammie Rockford. Trustee Gordon was present by phone. Joe Roesch was also present.

A motion was made by Trustee Carlson, seconded by Trustee Leonard, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Upon a roll call vote, there were 5 Yeas – 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Trustee Leonard, seconded by Trustee Rockford, to approve payment of the Supervisor/Collector/General Assistance Administration Expenditures, in the amount of \$7,450.00. Upon a roll call vote, there were 5 Yeas – 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Trustee Carlson, seconded by Trustee Rockford, to approve payment of the Township Clerk/Township Assessor’s Administration Expenditures, in the amount of \$931.62. Upon a roll call vote, there were 5 Yeas – 0 Nays.

ANNUAL TOWN MEETING DISCUSSION

Supervisor Aiello stated the Annual Town Meeting is scheduled for April 11, 2023 at 6:01 p.m. The regularly scheduled meeting will be held at 5:30 p.m. that evening to accommodate the trustees and the public. A motion was made by Trustee Carlson, seconded by Trustee Leonard, to approve the Agenda for the Annual Town Meeting. A voice vote was unanimous. All attendees will have to check in and must be a resident of Capital Township.

SUPERVISOR'S UPDATE

Supervisor Aiello stated last month they approved the financial obligation to Heartland Housed and Josh Sabo has been here on several occasions to discuss the Heartland Housed Initiative. This board approved the agreement and the financial backing for that agreement. He thinks the City of Springfield approves theirs tomorrow, and Sangamon County has approved their agreement. They are very actively engaged in the homeless initiative and have worked with all the agencies that provide housing support for the homeless and those that will be placed in housing. They will continue to help at any level they can.

NEW BUSINESS

Trustee Rockford asked if there is a proposed start date for the reconstruction at the Juvenile Center. Supervisor Aiello stated he does not know the start date. Maybe they can get Byron Deaner in here next month to discuss this.

Trustee Gordon asked if they would house them all together or if they would split the juveniles in an area separate from the homeless. Supervisor Aiello stated they would be housed separately. There is a significant difference in the services provided. He does not think they would be able to get into each other's facilities. She asked if they would be upgrading the Juvenile Center. Supervisor Aiello stated he is not sure about the Juvenile Center. He could have Byron Deaner present at a future meeting to give more insight on this.

A motion was made by Trustee Carlson, seconded by Trustee Rockford, to adjourn the meeting to April 11, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. Upon a roll call vote, there were 5 Yeas – 0 Nays.
