The Board of Trustees met at the Taylorville Township Building at 7:00 p.m. on May 10th, 2023.

Roll call was taken. Trustees Graham, Berry and Frevert and Kretzer responded present. Supervisor Heberling responded present. Clerk Gronewald and Road Commissioner West responded present. Guests were Linda Lytle, Allen Kuhnert and Marcia Neal.

Motion to approve April's minutes was made by Trustee Graham and seconded by Trustee Berry. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve Supervisors bills was made by Trustee Kretzer and was seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve Highway Commissioners bills was made by Trustee Graham and seconded by Trustee Frevert. All said aye and motion was passed.

Supervisor Heberling discussed that the Township has a credit in the unemployment account of \$1,447.46 due to the repayment of a prior employee receiving unemployment fraudulently. Also discussed was that the Employee health insurance renewal is going up by approximately \$67.00. Meeting specifics for the Local Government Efficiency Committee Act program were outlined with the board members and the participants, Linda Lytle, Allen Kuhnert and Marcia Neal. August 9th and November 8th were chosen as the dates for the LGEC to meet. The roof project has started and Supervisor Heberling wants to plan an open house when it is finished. Also discussed was the newly formed partnership with the Salvation Army helping out the homeless in the community. The program enables the participants to have a safe place to transition and gain employment upon successfully following the guidelines set forth by the Salvation Army. Supervisor Heberling and Office Manager, Missy Ruff had a pivotal role in getting the program implemented.

Road Commissioner West discussed the heavy rainfall caused some flooding in the Langleyville area. It was assessed and steps were taken to remedy the situation.
