Who We Are

AgeLinc, the Area Agency on Aging for Lincolnland is Your Link to Aging Well.

AgeLinc is a planning and service agency that partners with the Illinois Department on Aging and receives Older American Act funds to develop programs and services for persons 60 years and older, disabled adults, and family caregivers. We work to create an awareness of aging and caregiving issues and encourage the development and coordination of services to address these issues.

We are a nonprofit governed by a Board of Directors and Advisory Council and serve twelve central Illinois counties. We are one of thirteen Area Agencies on Aging in Illinois and one of over 600 in the nation.

What We Do

AgeLinc awards grants and contracts to service providers for services such as Transportation, Congregate and Home Delivered Meals, Information and Assistance, Caregiver Counseling, Legal Assistance, Long-Term Care Ombudsman and In-Home Respite Care.

Our office provides these services:

- Benefit Access Assistance (Reduced License Plate Fee and Free City Bus Passes)
- Caregiver and Relative Caregivers of Children Support
- Evidence Based Programs (Aging Mastery, Stress Busters, etc.)
- Evening Community Education Programs
- Dementia Friendly Programs
- Social Isolation Programs and Support
- Support for LGBT+ Older Adults and Caregivers (Sage Care Certified)
- Medicare Part D Open Enrollment
- Aging and Disability Information & Referrals
