Motion to approve July minutes was made by Trustee Graham and seconded by Trustee Kretzer. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve Highway Commissioners bills was made by Trustee Berry and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed.

Supervisor Heberling discussed the need for a changing table for the women's restroom and a chair dolly for the folding chairs. She also discussed receiving another letter from the I.R.S., which she is going to respond to promptly. A letter was received from the Illinois Department of Employment Security stating a former worker's paid claim was deemed fraudulent. A new map was presented from the Christian County Supervisor of Assessments showing the updated populations. An e-mail was received from Navigator CO2 Ventures, LLC advising that the proposed route of the pipeline may pass within the boundaries of Christian County or Taylorville Township.
