The Board of Trustees met at the Taylorville Township building at 7:00 p.m. on March 9th, 2022.

Roll call was taken . Trustees Kretzer, Graham, Berry and Frevert responded present. Supervisor Heberling and Road commissioner West responded present. Township Clerk Gronewald responded present. Also in attendance were Cindy Brown, Nick Verardi and Kent Collebrusco.

Motion to approve February minutes was made by Trustee Graham and seconded by Trustee Kretzer. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve Supervisors bills was made by Trustee Graham and seconded by Trustee Berry. All said aye and the motion was passed.

Motion to approve Highway Commissioners bills was made by Trustee Kretzer and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed.

Supervisor Heberling asked to let the guests speak ahead of the rest of the meeting. Kent Collebrusco detailed the long standing drainage problems in Langleyville. Road Commissioner West agreed to meet with him on a future date to be scheduled.

Supervisor Heberling announced that the Township received a dividend check from TOIRMA in the amount of \$4,688.00. She also discussed the ongoing situation of a former employees Unemployment claim, the Open Meetings Act to be completed by the trustees, the possibility of rekeying all doors in the building and the updates on the remodel. Updates included the Replacement of the overhead lights and new switch plates and plug in plates.

Road Commissioner West discussed the New Employee Hand Book, the newly installed time clock and the tile replacement progress on Willowford Rd. He stated they are waiting on J.U.L.I.E to Move on to the next phase. Commissioner West questioned the high bill for the gas and gas tank and that payment was put on hold until more information could be obtained.

Motion to approve Health insurance for Road Commissioner West was made by Trustee Graham and seconded by Trustee Berry. All said aye by means of a roll call vote and motion was passed.

Trustee Kretzer questioned the high electric/gas bill and the possibility of getting up to date furnaces and or solar panels.
