PLANNING COMMISSION – There was no meeting, no correspondence, no report at this time.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Von Bergen reported still working on the books & needing to get with the building inspector for the improvements not recorded. There is a continual problem with people not wanting to be measured. The spring conference has been rescheduled to October & will apply for a refund.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported finishing the second mowing, paved & paved with Greenwood Township, cleaning brush, storm damage & Richmond Township helped with the boom truck. The railroad is scheduled to begin around August or September. Burgett Rd east of Lange Rd will be closed on Saturday. State Representative Steve Reick sent Township grant paperwork to the village and it was never forwarded and he was never notified that it went there in error. He checked in just in time and Supervisor Lech & Karen Lalor were able to help complete the application for \$150k. Commissioner Nickels would like to recognize and thank them for all their help.

TRUSTEES – There was no report at this time.

CEMETERY – 2 staking's, 0 grave sales.

SUPERVISOR: GREEN STREET – no payment received. GA – There were no inquiries. ADMINISTRATION – The Auditor is working on the Financial Statement. Linda Wappler is ill and Sue Nelson was hired as a temp to clean the building while she recovers. TOI has canceled its classes for the year.

CLERK – Clerk Elswick reported filing the 2020-2021 budgets with the county.
