THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES met at the Robinson Township Office at 6:00P.M. January 19, 2012.

The following official business was transacted. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Larry McCoy. Clerk Vickie Gribben then called the roll.

Persons from the public attending the meeting were as follows: Becky Taylor, Janie Thackrey, Gary Wilson, and Matthew Wilson.

Under Item 4, Mr. McCoy asked if the trustees had any questions or changes concerning the minutes of December 15, 2011. There being none, Shirley Berry made the motion, seconded by Sue Roberts, to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried with vote as follows: Larry McCoy-yes; Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes.

Under Item 5A, the Supervisor's report, Chairman McCoy referred the Board to their copies of the monthly account balances paper for December 31, 2011 and read the beginning and ending balances for the Total Town and Total Road and Bridge Money Market accounts. Mr. McCoy noted the interest rates and maturity values the Township is currently receiving on the certificates of deposits invested with First Robinson Savings Bank. He also told the Board that remodeling of the Township building would be starting Monday, January 23, 2012.

Under Item B, Janie Thackrey, Mr. Lachenmayr's secretary, told the Board that Mr. Lachenmayr was on a mission trip to the Phillipines. She also stated that the Highway Department's crew was currently trimming trees.

Under Item 5C, the Assessor's report, Mr. Manning told the trustees he has scheduled required continuing education classes to be held in March in Bloomington. He has done about four million in assessments and noted that there had been lots of demolition on North Cross and Jefferson Streets.

Under New Business, Item 6A, Chairman McCoy informed the trustees that Statements of Economic Interest need to be filled out and given to the Township Clerk.

Under New Business, Item 6B, the trustees discussed the Assessor's proposed budget for the fiscal year 2012-2013 which Mr. Manning had given them at the December 15, 2011 Township meeting.

Item 7C: Shirley Berry made a motion, seconded by Larry McCoy, to pre approve payment of elected officials for the time period of January 20, 2012 through February 16, 2012. Motion carried with vote as follows: Larry McCoy-yes; Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes.

Item 8: Glenda Fulling made a motion, seconded by Larry McCoy, to pay per diem. Motion carried with vote as follows: Larry McCoy-yes; Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes.

Shirley Berry moved to adjourn the meeting with all in favor voting aye. Larry McCoy seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:18 P.M.
