Minutes of the Public Hearing Held December 13, 2021
Proposed 2021 Tax Levy Ordinance for Berwyn Township
To be Collected in 2022

Clerk's Note: The Berwyn Township Board of Trustees conducted this meeting remotely under Governor Pritzker's Emergency and Executive Orders allowing elected officials to participate in public meetings remotely due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The Township is using the Zoom app platform for its meetings. All elected officials and staff participated remotely. The Township Board posted directions for public to participate in the meeting at its principal place of business and on its website.

1. Clerk Paul called the Public Hearing to Order at 5:45 p.m. There was no one in attendance.
2. Clerk Paul announced that the Notice of Meeting and Agenda for the Public Hearing the Lawndale News on December 2, 2021 and presented a copy of the Proof of Publication. Notice of Meeting and Agenda for this meeting were also posted in the location where the Town Board meets at 6600 W. 26th Street, Berwyn, Illinois.
3. Clerk Paul read the title of the following Ordinances into the record: **An Ordinance Levying Taxes for all Town Purposes Berwyn Township, Cook County, Illinois for the Tax Year 2021 Collectible in 2022.**
4. Clerk Paul closed the Public Hearing at 5:50 p.m.
5. Clerk Paul reopened the Public Hearing at 6:00 p.m. for anyone attending the regularly scheduled Berwyn Township December remote meeting.
6. Town Supervisor Avila, Town Attorney Zdarsky, Town Accountant Egan were present in the remote meeting room. She reiterated the publication date of the Notice of Meeting for the Public Hearing and lack of comment or requests by anyone to attend the Public Hearing. For the record, Clerk Paul requested Mr. Eagan to review the proposed Berwyn Township Tax Levy Ordinance. Mr. Eagan commented on the ordinance.
