## ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION – There was no meeting, no correspondence, no report at this time.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Von Bergen reported waiting on the county for the okay to send in her books, there are a few larger townships in front of hers, received a stack of permits from the village building inspector and responding to real estate sales.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported working on patching, brush, trees, equipment, 2 days of boom mowing, 500 tires recycled, the railroad crossing will now start in October and spent ½ day fixing the fence at the cemetery.

TRUSTEES – Trustee Reed announced a blood drive scheduled for Sunday at Emrickson Park in Woodstock.

CEMETERY – 2 staking's, 0 grave sales, emptied the garbage & fixed the fence with the road districts assistance. There was a discussion on cemetery bid & mowing specs.

SUPERVISOR: GREEN STREET – Received August's payment on Sept 2<sup>nd</sup>, nothing for September yet.

GA – There was one application pending. ADMINISTRATION – The Auditor is finished, waiting on the AFR to be filed online. Building Loan, Supervisor Lech spoke with loan officer Jeff Vohs, APR is 3.9% and because it is a commercial loan it can not be taken for an extended period, 5-7 year fixed.

Building usage, under 50 people & no disinfection materials supplied, must bring your own.

CLERK – Clerk Elswick reported petitions circulation period will start soon, more information to come.

OLD BUSINESS – There was discussion on the salaries for the new term & tabled.

NEW BUSINESS– Youth/Seniors Committee Line Item for next Fiscal Year, there was a discussion on adding this and starting out with a small amount to try and give back a little to the community. Some concerns being how would it be divided equally, who and what would be worthy. No action was taken.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – Many thanks for boom mowing on Seaman Rd.

ADJOURNMENT – The meeting adjourned at 8:11 pm.
