Supervisor's Report:

- **No new uses of the building.**
- **FCC paperwork has been approved by the government agency. Now it goes to the group that will identify the frequency to be used.**
- **Township Official cards were handed out.**

Road Commissioner's Report:

- **Tree sap has not been applied due to the weather conditions.**
- **217th Street N just keeps getting more rock put down. Geologist went down 35 feet and it was still sugar clay. He also went down 15 feet at the bottom of the hill and then got blue clay.**
- **The R&B crew has been working with Port Byron to assist with the storm damage clean-up in Timber Ridge subdivision. Took 10 loads today of tree limbs and chips. Port Byron rented the largest chipper available to assist.**
- **A landowner in Byron Hills decided that he didn't need to have a culvert anymore and now the rain is backing up in the neighbor's yard.**
- **Motor Fuel tax is on hold until the State of Illinois has a budget – we may need to adjust the amount of seal coating done.**

- **One parcel in Coe Township has been deemed inhabitable.**

- **Waiting on the password to file the State Comptroller report and then we will publish the Annual Report in the Review.**
