The Board of Trustees met at the Taylorville Township Building at 7:00 p.m. on May 11th, 2022.

Roll call was taken. Trustees Kretzer, Graham, Berry and Frevert responded present. Supervisor Heberling responded present. Township Clerk Gronewald responded present. Highway Commissioner West responded present. Guests were Kevin Handy of Graham and Hyde Architects, Inc. and Richard Wiseman.

Motion to approve April minutes was made by Trustee Berry and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve Supervisors bills was made by Trustee Berry and was seconded by Trustee Frevert. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve Highway Commissioners bills was made by Trustee Frevert and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve the bid process for the roof repair by Graham and Hyde Architects was made by Trustee Kretzer and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve payment for services rendered, painting, to Missy Ruff in the amount of \$599.00 was made by Trustee Berry and seconded by Trustee Frevert. All said aye and motion was passed.

Supervisor Heberling discussed an increase in health insurance by \$11.00 per person. Also discussed was the increase by TOI of \$30,000.00 subject to bidding process. The spring cleanup effort was deemed unsuccessful as the citizens of the Township did not participate at a rate that was feasible to the cost of the set up. Supervisor Heberling also requested a motion to pay Missy Ruff for her work painting the inside of the Township building.

Highway commissioner West discussed that he intends to oil and rock approximately 15 to 18 miles of roads within the township and that work on culverts is done.

Guest Kevin Handy discussed the process of inspecting the roof and bidding of the job and answered questions.

Guest Richard Wiseman advised the board on his opinions of the sewer situation in Hewittville and his lengthy experience with said sewer problems was duly noted.
