MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON TOWNSHIP JULY 25, 2011

The Board of Trustees for the Town of the City of Bloomington Township met in the Conference Room of City Hall Building at 6:33 P.M. on July 25, 2011.

The meeting was called to order by Trustee Stockton and the following were present:

Trustees: Steven Purcell, David Sage, Bernard Anderson, Judy Stearns, Jim Fruin, Rob Fazzini, Jennifer McDade, Mboka Mwilambwe and Steve Stockton.

Trustee absent: Karen Schmidt.

Also present were Staff: Tracey Covert, Town Clerk and Joe Gibson, Township Supervisor.

Staff absent: Mike Ireland, Township Assessor.

The Minutes of June 27, 2011 Regular Session were presented.

Motion by Trustee Anderson, seconded by Trustee McDade that the reading of the Minutes June 27, 2011 Regular Session meeting be dispensed with and approved as presented.

Motion carried.

Trustee Sage arrived at 6:36 p.m.

The audit for the General Town Fund and the General Assistance Fund and Exhibit A. Request for Payment were presented for June 2011.

Motion by Trustee McDade, seconded by Trustee Anderson, to approve the audits as presented and place on file.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, McDade, Anderson, Sage, Fruin, Fazzini, Stearns, Mwilambwe and Stockton.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

The anticipated expenditures were presented.

Motion by Trustee Fazzini, seconded by Trustee McDade, to approve the anticipated expenditures.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, Sage, Anderson, Stearns, Fruin, Fazzini, McDade, Mwilambwe and Stockton.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

Joe Gibson, Township Supervisor, introduced Cathy Hadden, Township Comptroller, and Rick Phillips, Phillips & Associates, CPAs, PC.

Rick Phillips, outside auditor, addressed the Board. He presented a brief overview of the Annual Financial Report. The Township operated on a modified cash basis. The Township had been given an unqualified opinion. No management analysis had been done. There were no material weaknesses. There were no findings of noncompliance. The financial condition of the Township was good. Year end assets equaled \$2,450,203 or approximately one (1) year of coverage. Revenues were in excess of expenditures. He reviewed the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances Arising from Cash Transactions, (see page 5).

General auditing procedures had been performed. There were no significant findings. There were no difficulties with management. A second opinion had not been sought. This audit had been completed under a one (1) year agreement. There were no retention conditions.

Trustee Fruin noted that as usual the Township had received a good report. He cited the Township's fund balance, (\$2,196,680). He questioned how this figure compared to prior years. Mr. Phillips noted that the net change was \$53,000. Trustee Fruin questioned how this figure compared to other townships. Mr. Phillips noted that the year end balance varied with the township. The goal was to have a carryover balance which equaled six to nine (6-9) months of anticipated expenditures. He cited the property tax cycle. The General Assistance (GA) Fund had seen some unexpected increases. Trustee Fruin wanted to confirm the Board's philosophical approach. He added that the year end balance was growing.

Mr. Gibson stated that the property tax levy had been lowered. He anticipated that GA expenses would increase. GA staff was trying to control expenses. Trustee Stockton noted the difference between the Town Fund and GA Fund. The GA Fund required more flexibility.

Trustee Fazzini questioned the consequence of insufficient funds. Mr. Phillips stated that the Board would have to issue tax anticipation warrants. Mr. Gibson cited Decatur Township as an example. This township did not have any funds for GA.

Trustee Fazzini questioned why the Management Discussion and Analysis had not been prepared. Mr. Phillips cited GASB (Governmental Accounting Standard Board) 34. This analysis had never been prepared. It would require supplemental information. He noted that of his firms forty-five to fifty (45-50) governmental accounts only one (1) had this analysis done. This document basically restated the financial report.

Trustee Fazzini questioned if an RFP (Request for Proposal) for accounting services had been issued in the last five (5) years. Mr. Gibson stated his intention to work with City of Bloomington to issue a joint RFP for auditing services. The goal was to obtain better pricing. Trustee Fazzini stated his interest in quality auditing services not just a low price. Mr. Gibson had reviewed historical expenditures for auditing services. This cost has been controlled. He understood the need to re-examine auditing services on a periodic basis. Trustee Fazzini restated that quality should come before price. He suggested a three (3) year time line be used. Mr. Gibson hoped to have additional information by the Board's August 22, 2011 meeting.

Trustee Fruin noted that his comments were not personal. He cited good business practices and encouraged the Township to issue an RFP. Some efficiencies have been gained. He restated that there should be an annual review of the Township's RFP process.

Trustee Fazzini questioned a combined City/Township RFP for auditing services. Mr. Phillips stated that based on the size of his firm, he would only submit a proposal for the Township. Mr. Gibson added that the Township Cemetery (Evergreen) would also be involved.

Trustee Fruin requested a time table by the Board's August 22, 2011 meeting.

Trustee Stockton noted that the report was reassuring. He appreciated Mr. Phillips and the Township staff's efforts. He cited the clean audit. Mr. Phillips noted the good working relationship with Township staff. The process was efficient and controlled costs.

Trustee Fruin addressed the Township funding community agencies. This appeared to be a second level of United Way. He struggled with balance. He questioned basic government services. Mr. Gibson noted that the Township was providing less assistance than it did two (2) years ago. He addressed the Community Health Care Clinic, (CHCC). These funds allowed the CHCC to hire a pharmacy technician. He had scheduled a meeting with CHCC to further reduce the Township's pharmacy costs. These dollars benefit the Township and assist GA staff to control and/or reduce costs. He cited the GA's office goal: to make a difference in GA clients' lives.

It was noted that Mike Ireland, Township Assessor, was on vacation. He had filed a written report in his absence.

Mr. Gibson presented his monthly report. A written report had been prepared. The numbers for GA had increased in June, (195). He planned to watch the numbers closely. GA expenses were even. GA staff was addressing medical costs including prescription drugs. GA staff had been extremely busy, (331 appointments during June). The biggest concern was utility assistance as there was little assistance elsewhere. Both the federal and state governments had eliminated their programs.

Trustee Anderson addressed fall heating costs. He believed that fifty percent (50%) of program recipients viewed these payments as an entitlement.

Mr. Gibson addressed employment. There had been some success stories, (full time employment). He addressed the Community Work/Education, (Community Service – 66; Drug Court – 2; GED Classes – 8; and Life Skills Class – 8). He also addressed new Work Sites, (West Side Revitalization, and Centennial Christian Church, additional hours were available at Safe Harbor, Center for Hope and Boys & Girls Club).

Trustee Stockton questioned the impact of unemployment benefits. Mr. Gibson noted that the federal extensions had ended. This fact was impacting GA.

Trustee Stockton noted the City's grant to the Bloomington/Normal Public Transit System for the J-Teal line. Mr. Gibson recalled that there had been several GA clients who used this bus line for transportation to work. Trustee Stockton requested that the Township watch same over the next year. Mr. Gibson added that a number of GA clients were employed in area restaurants.

Trustee Stockton introduced the Cemetery Board, (Gene Lorch and Gene Keiser). He noted the request to appoint Pamela Eaton to the Board. Ms. Eaton was a forty (40) year resident. She resided several blocks from the Cemetery, (Marie Litta's home). Russell Francois had contacted Ms. Eaton about serving on this board. She believed in community participation. She planned to be buried at Evergreen Cemetery. Ms. Eaton was a local elementary teacher. She and her husband operated a local Downtown art gallery.

Trustee Sage thanked Ms. Eaton for her willingness to serve. He had been impressed and overwhelmed by this Board. Gene Lorch, Cemetery Trustee, addressed the Board. The Cemetery Board had three (3) members. Tom Jennings had resigned.

Motion by Trustee Fruin, seconded by Trustee Anderson that the appointment be approved.

Motion carried, (viva voce).

Trustee Fazzini questioned Statements of Interest. Trustee Stockton noted that they were on file in the City Administration office.

Trustee Stockton opened the meeting to Public Comment. No one came forward to address the Board.

Motion by Trustee Anderson, seconded by Trustee Mwilambwe to adjourn. Time: 7:15 p.m.
