MINUTES
CAPITAL TOWNSHIP BOARD

APRIL 11, 2023

The Capital Township Board of Trustees met in the County Board Chambers, 2nd floor County Building. The board stood for the Pledge of Allegiance. The following members answered to roll call: Joe Aiello, Brad Carlson, Ken Leonard, and Tammie Rockford. Joe Roesch, Justin Reichert and Mark Crawford were also present.

A motion was made by Trustee Rockford, seconded by Trustee Carlson, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Trustee Carlson, seconded by Trustee Leonard, to approve payment of the Supervisor/Collector/General Assistance Administration Expenditures, in the amount of \$750.00. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.

A motion was made by Trustee Leonard, seconded by Trustee Carlson, to approve payment of the Township Clerk/Township Assessor's Administration Expenditures, in the amount of \$442.46. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.

SUPERVISOR UPDATE/OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS

Supervisor Aiello recognized and congratulated Mr. Carlson on his recent election to City of Springfield Alderperson. He stated that once someone is sworn in as an alderperson they surrender their position on the Capital Township Board unless they submit a resignation letter prior to that.

Supervisor asked Mr. Reichert, the Township Board legal representative, if he had any comments. Mr. Reichert responded by concurring that once someone is sworn into the new position the seat on the Capital Township Board becomes vacant.

Aiello thanked Mr. Carlson for his service and said he may participate in another meeting depending on when the swearing ceremony will be held. Once the vacancy occurs, they have 60 days to fill that vacancy.

Supervisor Aiello noted that Trustee Gordon entered the meeting and directed Clerk Gray to mark her in attendance.

A motion was made by Trustee Carlson, seconded by Trustee Leonard, to adjourn the meeting to May 8, 2023 at 12:00 p.m. Upon a roll call vote, there were 5 Yeas – 0 Nays.
