**MINUTES**

**CAPITAL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

**FEBRUARY 10, 2020**

**CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL**

The Capital Township Board of Trustees met in the office of the Supervisor. The following members answered to roll call: Joe Aiello, Richard Berning, Brad Carlson, and Alysse Aiello Hewell. Lakeisha Purchase-Williams was excused. Mark Crawford was also present. Justin Reichert was present as Legal Counsel.

**MINUTES**

A motion was made by Trustee Berning, seconded by Trustee Carlson, for approval of the Minutes of the January 13, 2020 meeting. A voice vote was unanimous.

**SUPERVISOR/GENERAL ASSISTANCE EXPENDITURES**

A motion was made by Trustee Berning, seconded by Trustee Aiello Hewell, to approve payment of the Supervisor/Collector/General Assistance Administration Expenditures in the amount of \$419.87. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.

**TOWN CLERK/TOWN ASSESSOR EXPENDITURES**

A motion was made by Trustee Carlson, seconded by Trustee Berning, to approve payment of the Township Clerk/Township Assessor's Administration Expenditures in the amount of \$230.68. Upon a roll call vote, there were 4 Yeas – 0 Nays.

### **SUPERVISOR'S UPDATE**

Supervisor Aiello gave an update on General Assistance. He stated they are working through issues with some clients, and have been talking with Peoria County to look at some of their programs. They are also working on getting better signage for the General Assistance facility. He will have a statistical report for the board next month. They will be immersing themselves into the programs with Community Resources and SIU School of Medicine to be hand in hand on services.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Trustee Berning asked if there has been any additional information from the realtor on the old building. Supervisor Aiello stated he has not heard anything recently from Jim Fulgenzi. He will talk with Jim about it. Mark Crawford stated there was an anonymous call that came in from someone inquiring about what they will be doing with the building. Supervisor Aiello stated he could get Jim Fulgenzi to come in and talk to the board. Jim did say they should not expect to get a lot out of that building.

Trustee Berning asked what is going on with the Township merger. Supervisor Aiello stated there has been no activity on the bill. There is a one-paragraph article on WMAY's website about it. Clerk Gray stated there was discussion about it on Jim Leach's Hour with the Mayor. There is talk of seeking a new legislative proposal to eliminate all townships, not just Capital, and they are looking at ways to save the taxpayer's money.

### **ADJOURN**

A motion was made by Trustee Berning, seconded by Trustee Carlson, to adjourn the meeting to March 9, 2020 at Noon. A voice vote was unanimous.
