

**Minutes – Board of Town Trustees  
July 17, 2014**

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES met at the Robinson Township Office at 6:00 p.m. July 17, 2014.

The following official business was transacted. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Larry McCoy. Clerk Vickie Gribben then called the roll.

The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited.

Persons from the public attending the meeting were as follows: Becky Taylor, Janie Thackrey, Gary Wilson, and Matthew Wilson.

Item 4, Mr. McCoy asked for public comments. There were none.

Item 5, Approval of minutes of previous meeting. He asked if the trustees had any questions or changes concerning the minutes of the June 19, 2014 regular monthly board meeting. There being none, Greg Wolfe made the motion, seconded by Shirley Berry, to approve the minutes for the meeting as written. Motion carried with vote as follows: Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Under Item 6A, the Supervisor’s report, Mr. McCoy passed the trustees pictures of the reset foundations for headstones in Robinson New Cemetery. He told the trustees he would take “before” pictures in future. Pat Richards asked if the cemetery crew were doing the work. Mr. McCoy responded that they were. Mr. McCoy then referred the board to their copies of the investment lists, GA lists and monthly account balances. He asked if there were any questions. There being none, he moved to the next report.

Under Item 6B, the Highway Commissioner’s report, Mr. Lachenmayr said that the road crew has finished the first mowing and gone through all the mowers and tractors getting ready for the second mowing which will be started in two weeks. For now he will have the crew mow the intersections. He said road patching will continue as well as brush trimming. He said he had one man down with shoulder surgery. He said it has been very busy but the department is getting a lot done.

Under Item 6C, Assessor's report, Mrs. Roberts said she is beginning to get caught up. There are new houses going up which is a good sign for the town's economy. Mrs. Roberts stated that the property taxes have been mailed and the calls are coming in. Mrs. Roberts said that she has had several people comment to her on how nice the Robinson New Cemetery looks.

Item 7A, Bid for front porch at the cemetery house. Mr. McCoy said two bids were received, one from Maxwell Concrete for \$4000.00. The bid from Maxwell Concrete included a 10'x20' porch with 2 steps and a 4'x4' walk. The second bid was from the Amish, Coblenz Masonry for \$3200.00. Greg Wolfe asked if the Amish bid included the walk. Mr. McCoy responded that, according to Stan Mullins, the cemetery sexton, both bids were identical. Pat Richards asked about insurance coverage. Mr. McCoy said the motion could be made that both companies provide proof of insurance and compliance with state regulations. After further discussion, the motion was made by Mr. McCoy and seconded by Pat Richards to table the bid for the front porch until the August 21, 2014 meeting. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; and Shirley Berry-yes.

Item 8A, Pat Richards moved to approve payment of Town, G.A., and Payroll bills. Greg Wolfe seconded the motion. Motion carried with vote as follows: Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes.

Item 8B, Larry McCoy made a motion to pay the Road District bills. Greg Wolfe seconded the motion. Motion carried with vote as follows: Larry McCoy-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes; and Greg Wolfe-yes.

Item 8C: Shirley Berry made a motion, seconded by Greg Wolfe, to pre-approve payment of elected officials for the time period of July 18, 2014 through August 21, 2014. Motion carried with vote as follows: Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; and Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 9: Shirley Berry made a motion, seconded by Pat Richards, to pay per diem. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; and Shirley Berry.

Item 10: Adjourn Meeting: Motion was made by Shirley Berry and seconded by Larry McCoy to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried with all in favor voting aye. Meeting adjourned at 6:16 p.m.
