

PROCEEDINGS OF A TOWN MEETING

Hebron Township 10206 Seaman Hebron, Illinois 60034
October 13, 2021

CALL TO ORDER - At the Regular Town Meeting, held in the town of Hebron, County of McHenry, and State of Illinois, at 7:03p.m. on the 13th day of October was called to order by Nancy Lech, Township Supervisor. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present – Trustee Rebecca Werra, Trustee Mike Von Bergen, Trustee Sammie Mayerck, Trustee Susan Reed, Supervisor Nancy Lech, Clerk Patricia Elswick, Assessor Shannon Combs & Road Commissioner Zeke Nickels.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES – Regular September 8, 2021 meeting minutes – Trustee Von Bergen motion to approve the minutes. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call votes Ayes – 5: Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck, Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed & Supervisor Lech. Nays – 0. Motion passed.

APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES/BILLS –Town Fund Bills – Trustee Reed motion to approve Town Fund expenditures in the amount of \$10,890.53. Second Trustee. Roll call votes Ayes – 5: Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck, Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed & Supervisor Lech. Nays – 0. Motion passed. General Assistance Fund Bills – Trustee Mayerck motion to approve General Assistance Fund expenditures in the amount of \$83.30. Second Trustee Reed. Roll call votes Ayes – 5: Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck, Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed & Supervisor Lech. Nays – 0. Motion passed. Cemetery Fund Bills – Trustee Reed motion to approve Cemetery Fund expenditures in the amount of \$2,528.87. Second Trustee Mayerck. Roll call votes Ayes – 5: Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck, Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed & Supervisor Lech. Nays – 0. Motion passed. Road District Bills – Trustee Mayerck motion to approve Road District Building & Equipment expenditures in the amount of \$0.00, Hard Road Fund expenditures in the amount of \$6,638.32 and Road & Bridge Fund expenditures in the amount of \$131,153.67. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call votes Ayes – 5: Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck, Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed & Supervisor Lech. Nays – 0. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS – Brandon Meier gave the warrantee paperwork, state flag, key and instructions on how the flagpole works. He also donated \$346 of excess funds raised for his Eagle Scout Project back to the township.

ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION – There was no meeting & no report at this time.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Combs reported measurements & photos completed on the KLM homes, still working with the county on turning in the books as they are trying to finish the larger townships first & received permits from the Village.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported patching, mowing, boom mowing with Geils for one day around poles, shouldering completed, worked on equipment, cemetery driveway & trees. There is a nationwide sensor shortage and the Pete is still down. Found a used 2005 truck for \$39.5k plan to sell the boom to pay down faster. There was a problem with the bulk salt bid, waiting to hear back on the price. Railroad crossing lights have been approved for Seaman Rd & may pave when that is scheduled.

TRUSTEES – There were no trustee reports at this time.

CLERK – There was one completed FOIA request pertaining to the Green Street Property.

CEMETERY – 3 staking, 3 grave sales, \$100 donation was given to Supervisor Lech when they witnessed her working up there. Thank you to Zeke & his crew for their work up there.

SUPERVISOR: GREEN STREET – Tried twice to close now. The second time the legal description that is on the contract does not match that on the McHenry County Recorder of Deeds. Mike Smoran was given Scott Pumas contact information. So far just costing the township legal fees and Supervisor Lech & Clerk Elswick having to take time off work to meet with the lawyer in Crystal Lake to sign documents. GENERAL ASSISTANCE – 0 applications & 1 inquiry. ADMIN/BUILDING – 4H group is back using the building the first two Mondays of the month. The display sign has been updated. Elected official payroll is currently being paid at the beginning of the month and at the first of the year will be paid out at the end of the month after the time served has passed. Supervisor Lech attended McHenry County Supervisors meeting; guest speaker went over current housing authority programs.

OLD BUSINESS – There was no old business discussed at this time.

NEW BUSINESS – There was no new business discussed at this time.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – There was no public comments at this time.

ADJOURNMENT – The meeting adjourned at 7:29pm.
