The Board of Trustees met at the Taylorville Township Building at 7:00 p.m. on February 9th, 2022.

Roll call was taken. Trustees Kretzer, Graham, Berry and Frevert responded present. Supervisor Heberling responded present remotely due to Covid exposure. Township Clerk Gronewald responded present. Highway Commissioner West was recorded absent due to having medical tests..

Motion to approve January minutes was made by Trustee Graham and seconded by Trustee Berry. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve Supervisors bills was made by Trustee Graham and was seconded by Trustee Kretzer. The addition of the insurance payment in the bills was also included in the motion. All said aye and the motion was passed.

Motion to approve Highway Commissioners bills was made by Trustee Frevert and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed.

Supervisor Heberling discussed an issue with a leak in the roof over her office and the need to get it fixed. Also discussed was the need for repairs to one of the two furnaces which is not working at this time. An employee timeclock is also being installed to better track employee hours and sick days. It is to be installed by the first day of fiscal year 2022. Ashcans are going to be placed outside the building for smokers to dispose of their smoking refuse.

Supervisor Heberling also discussed the remodel progress. Light fixtures are to be replaced and Charlie Samson is painting the strips in the ceiling tiles. Also discussed were the Town and Road District budgets. The legal fees are to be increased to \$50,000.00 in the Town budget. Both budgets were signed by Trustees and all said aye.

An email was received from Langleyville resident, Kent Collebrusco, detailing issues in town and asking for consideration of attention to said problems.

Motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Frevert and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed and adjournment was at 7:54 p.m.
