

**Resolution # 22-09
Kendall Township
Recognition of Service Policy**

I. Recognize Longevity

The individual should have a minimum of 20 years of service to the township in any role. This could be cumulative of different roles. Exceptions could be made to this time period parameter, but only after discussion and reasoning provided.

II. Note Milestones/Contributions

The individual should have some type of milestone achievement other than just time served. For example, an individual may have served for years as an elected official, but also did many other things for the township and the residents thereof.

III. Celebrate the Township's Positive Reputation


The person should have been above reproach in his/her actions while working for or on behalf of the residents of the township. This could also include contributions to society outside of the role within township government.
