Highway Commissioner:

- have information from IL-DOT – will be receiving a grant to replace signage (amount unknown at this time) ... street signs need to be replaced by the end of 2015, road signs need to be replaced by end of 2016
- 1<sup>st</sup> part of work done on 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave (Snake Hollow Rd), and 108<sup>th</sup> St (Bethel Rd) chip and seal done, on 217<sup>th</sup> St the Road Crew is working on the ditch – there was a mudslide, hopefully work will be done by the 19<sup>th</sup> of September – rip/rap was hauled in
- 3 new houses are being built in township, two on 80<sup>th</sup> St, one on Fairfield Rd
- 290<sup>th</sup> St work was done with Canoe Creek – they bought the material and we did the labor
- we're going to be getting some free rock from Port Byron, leftover from their road work, we can use it
- brush trimming continues
