

**Minutes – Board of Town Trustees  
December 20, 2012**

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES met at the Robinson Township Office at 6:00 p.m. December 20, 2012.

The following official business was transacted. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Larry McCoy. Clerk Vickie Gribben then called the roll.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited at the previous meeting.

Persons from the public attending the meeting were as follows: Gary and Matthew Wilson.

Under Item 4, Mr. McCoy asked if the trustees had any questions or changes concerning the minutes of the November 15, 2012 meeting. There being none, Pat Richards made the motion, seconded by Shirley Berry, to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried with vote as follows: Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Under Item 5A, the Supervisor's report, Mr. McCoy read the beginning and ending balances for the month ending November 30, 2012 in the Total Town Money Market and the Total Road and Bridge Money Market. He noted that the township had received the final disbursement of tax revenues. He mentioned the interest rate is still the same on the certificates of deposit -- 0.35%. Supervisor McCoy then noted the seventeen cases done through intergovernmental agreements for the fiscal year April 1, 2012 to November 30, 2012 resulting in a total received of \$1020.00. He stated the amounts disbursed through Robinson Township through General and Emergency assistance. He asked if there were any questions. There being none, Mr. McCoy asked for the Road Commissioner's report.

Under Item 5B, Highway Commissioner Lachenmayr told the Board that the Highway Department is ready for the winter weather. The road crew has spent the last month trimming trees with special attention to the big branches overhanging the roadways. Mr. McCoy asked if there were any questions for Mr. Lachenmayr. Sue Roberts asked what the Bridge Aid Account was. Mr. Lachenmayr responded that it was an account where the township received money from the county and the money could only be used for specific projects such as bridges, culverts and road crossings.

Under Item 5C, Assessor's report: Mr. McCoy dispensed with the Assessor's report as Mr. Manning was absent.

Under Item 6A, Continued Business, Adoption of the 2012 Road District Tax Levy collectible in 2013. Mr. McCoy asked for questions or discussion of the levy. There was none. Glenda Fulling made the motion to adopt said levy and Shirley Berry seconded. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-present; Glenda Fulling-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Under Item 6B, Continued Business, Cemetery Stone Resetting Bid: Mr. McCoy said he thought this item of business was discussed at October's meeting. Glenda Fulling had requested that a second bid be obtained through Adams Memorials. The bid from Effingham Monument was for \$9200.00. The bid from Adams Memorials was for \$10,900.00. Both bids stated the name of the monuments needing bases replaced. Sue Roberts asked how many more stones remain in need of repair. Mr. McCoy stated he had not done a count and mentioned that several mausoleums which were made from a composite of cement and rocks and covered the length of the grave were in need of attention. Pat Richards made the motion to approve the bid from Effingham Monument. Larry McCoy seconded the motion. Motion carried with vote as follows: Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes; Glenda Fulling-no; Pat Richards-yes; Larry McCoy-yes. Ms. Fulling said she would like to explain why she voted no. She said that Adams Memorials had a local business established here and paid taxes here. Mr. McCoy said that was fine. He said that Effingham Monument had been recommended to him and that, if the work done by Effingham Monument was not satisfactory, Adams Memorials would be given an opportunity to work on the stone resetting.

Item 7A: Larry McCoy moved to approve payment of the Town, G.A., and Payroll bills. Shirley Berry seconded. Motion carried with vote as follows: Sue Roberts-yes; Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 7B: Sue Roberts made a motion to pay the Road District bills. Larry McCoy seconded. Motion carried with vote as follows: Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 7C: Larry McCoy made a motion, seconded by Pat Richards, to pre approve payment of elected officials for the time period of December 21, 2012, through January 17, 2013. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes; Glenda Fulling-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 8: Sue Roberts made a motion, seconded by Larry McCoy, to pay per diem. Motion carried with vote as follows: Shirley Berry-yes; Sue Roberts-yes; Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 9: Adjourn Meeting: Motion was made by Sue Roberts to adjourn the meeting. Larry McCoy seconded. Motion carried with vote as follows: Sue Roberts-yes; Glenda Fulling-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Larry McCoy-yes. Meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
