**A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL  
REFERENDUM TO ELECTORS OF UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF STOOKEY**

**WHEREAS**, Stookey Township (“Township”) is a body politic of the County of St. Clair, State of Illinois, operating under the Illinois Township Code (60 ILCS 1 *et seq.*); and

**WHEREAS**, the electors of the unincorporated areas of the Township are desirous of obtaining a cost-effective means for refuse collection and disposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township finds it is necessary for the welfare of the electors to provide a means for refuse collection and disposal in the unincorporated areas of the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the power to regulate waste disposal in unincorporated areas of a township is conferred upon the Township pursuant to the Township Refuse Collection and Disposal Act, Article 210 of the Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/210 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to submit this public question to the electors in the unincorporated areas of the Township in the form of a referendum, 60 ILCS 1/210-5;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STOOKEY, AS FOLLOWS:**

- (1) The Board of Trustees of Stookey Township (“Board”) shall place this matter before the electors of the unincorporated areas of the Township.
- (2) The Board shall submit a certified copy of this Resolution to the St. Clair County Clerk for placement of this question, consistent with Illinois election law, on the ballot at the next regular scheduled election to be held within the Township.
- (3) The form of the referendum the Board shall submit to the St. Clair County Clerk as it should appear on the ballot is as follows:


**Proposition to Authorize the Township to Exercise the Powers of the  
Township Refuse Collection and Disposal Act:**

Shall the Township Board of Stookey Township, St. Clair County, Illinois, be authorized to exercise the powers of the “Township Refuse Collection and Disposal Act” as provided in Article 210 of the Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/210 <i>et seq.</i> to enter into a contract for the collection, disposal, composting or recycling of garbage, refuse and ashes within the unincorporated area of the Township?	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>YES</b>  <input type="checkbox"/> <b>NO</b>
