

**Minutes – Board of Town Trustees
June 19, 2014**

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES met at the Robinson Township Office at 6:00 p.m. June 19, 2014.

The following official business was transacted. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Larry McCoy. Clerk Vickie Gribben then called the roll.

The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited.

Persons from the public attending the meeting were as follows: Becky Taylor, Leon Taylor, Gary Wilson, Matthew Wilson, and Lacey Whipkey.

Item 4, Mr. McCoy asked for public comments. There were none.

Item 5, Approval of minutes of previous meeting. He asked if the trustees had any questions or changes concerning the minutes of the May 15, 2014 regular monthly board meeting. There being none, Lori Hodge made the motion, seconded by Pat Richards, to approve the minutes for the meeting as written. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Under Item 6A, the Supervisor's report, Mr. McCoy dispensed with reading the beginning and ending balances for the current month of the Township's money market accounts as the trustees all had copies of the balances. He referred to the intergovernmental agreement Robinson Township has with Oblong, Prairie, Licking, Montgomery, and Martin Townships to do the General Assistance paperwork. He concluded by mentioning the Township's investment list and stated that the interest rate had not changed-3/10ths of a per cent. He asked if there were any questions and moved to the next report.

Under Item 6B, the Highway Commissioner's report, Mr Lachenmayr said that the road crew is about two thirds done with first mowing. He said the weeds had gotten ahead of them, but the roadsides are starting to look good. The crew has had to replace a tractor tire at \$1000, and repair a shaft at \$300, and change out two more major culverts at \$2000 each. He said road patching will continue through the whole summer. He said the road seems to harden but he's found new breaks. He's planning on doing six miles of chipping and sealing. He said there's a problem with one stretch of 1 and 1/10 mile on Angling Road which was a bad spot when the crew repaired the road originally.

Under Item 6C, Assessor's report, there was none.

Item 7A, Larry McCoy moved to approve the Prevailing Wage Ordinance for the Town. He noted that the ordinance was mandated by the State of Illinois who also set the wages. Greg Wolfe seconded. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 7B, Pat Richards moved to approve the Prevailing Wage Ordinance for the Road District. Larry McCoy seconded. Motion carried with vote as follows: Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; Pat Richards-yes.

Item 8A, Lori Hodge moved to approve payment of Town, G.A., and Payroll bills. Greg Wolfe seconded the motion. Motion carried with vote as follows: Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; Pat Richards-yes; and Lori Hodge-yes.

Item 8B, Pat Richards made a motion to pay the Road District bills. Lori Hodge seconded the motion. Motion carried with vote as follows: Larry McCoy-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; and Greg Wolfe-yes.

Item 8C: Lori Hodge made a motion, seconded by Larry McCoy, to pre-approve payment of elected officials for the time period of June 20, 2014 through July 17, 2014. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; and Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 9: Pat Richards made a motion, seconded by Greg Wolfe, to pay per diem. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 10: Adjourn Meeting: Motion was made by Lori Hodge and seconded by Larry McCoy to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried with all in favor voting aye. Meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
