*Meeting is held under Covid 19 guidelines*

The October Reed Township Board meeting was called to order at 5:30P.M. by Supervisor Knorr. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

Those present at roll call were Trustees Steve Bolatto, Pam Tessler, and Brian Knorr. Also present was Highway commissioner Dixon.

A motion to approve the September meetings was made by Trustee Steve Bolatto; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. All in favor; motion carried.

Supervisor Knorr shared at the end of September our last big tax money was received. A motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Trustee Brian Knorr; second by Pam Tessler. All in favor; motion carried. Trustee Tessler asked about the refund from Torma; supervisor explained it is once a year.

A motion to approve the bills was made by Trustee Steve Bolatto; second by Trustee Brian Knorr. All in favor; motion carried.

Supervisor shared she went to the TIF meeting in Diamond and the one in Braidwood, nothing to report. The drive has been sealed and stripped.

The highway commissioner gave a brief description on a grant for \$20000 that is available through Will County it does have guide lines on useage. Trustee Tessler asked what the bill for Sistek was for;

commissioner explained the charges. A motion to approve the bills was made by Trustee Brian Knorr; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. All in favor; motion carried.

There was no assessor report.

The clerk reminded the board the Annual Town Meeting would be November 5 at 6:00P.M.

Trustee Tessler shared that TJ Sforza was here tonight as he would be interested in a board position if one is open. There is no opening as of now.

There was no old business.

A short discussion was held on the tax levy. Supervisor shared that her and the highway commissioner has discussed the levy. Both the town and highway will request between a 2 ½ percent and 3 percent increase. This would be about \$5000 for the Town n General; and about \$6500 for the highway department. The town n general is saving money toward capital improvement which is a pavilion that would be for the community use. The highway department has necessary repairs to the salt shed.

A motion to approve the request for the tax levy for Town n General was made by Trustee Pam Tessler; second by Trustee Steve Bolatto. All in favor; motion carried.

A motion to approve the request for the tax levy for Highway Department was made by Trustee Brian Knorr; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. All in favor; motion carried.

There was no public comment.

A motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Steve Bolatto; second by Trustee Pam Tessler. All in favor; motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 5:50P.M.
