

Minutes: Coe Township Cemetery Board Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:45pm:

The minutes from last meeting were distributed and – **Approved.**

Selected meeting dates for the year – (6 June, 5 September, 5 December 2017)

Old Business:

Complete:

Removal of dead trees at Fairfield cemetery.

License for Pleasant Point Cemetery is renewed through 2020.

Discussed who is responsible for repair costs to monuments if damaged by mowers, storms, vandals etc. It was reported that in the past the family was responsible for this. Paul added this to the rules and regulations document.

Not complete:

Posts are now available and ready to install. Need to locate service for Pleasant Point.

Cross reference list of lot owners to lot numbers done on paper but need to input in computer.

Request for hand held metal detector

Request for computer and printer in cemetery office

Discussed pricing for lots at both cemeteries. Ken and John obtained pricing information from both Port Byron and Cordova. We are less than ½ the price of both these cemeteries. Several proposals were discussed but action was tabled until all three board members good meet on just this one issue and come to a unanimous vote. **After much discussion it was decided to leave current pricing in effect until further notice.**

New Business:

Mowing contracts for 2017, Mike Saddoris to call provider to see if any wiggle room is possible.

Need two new 3 x 5 flags for the cemeteries, will Hillsdale or Port Byron Legions provide?

Re-applied for change of license at Pleasant Point from “partially exempt” to fully “exempt”. Paul has made the contacts and has completed the required forms. This will save the township about \$200 every four years. Mailed forms on 3/6/2017.

All sextons and board members agreed to serve for one more year. However for the board members, if there are others that would like to serve in our place, that would be fine also.
