## ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION – There was no meeting, the zoom zoning meeting for the Vaugh Bushnell property passed. It will have approximately \$2200 increase in taxes for the village now.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Von Bergen reported not much in the market, cleaning up files & tentative budget.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported plowing, salting, replacing signs, patching, working on equipment, salt was delivered, salt shed was repaired yesterday, clearing culverts, grant opened for railroad crossing on Seaman Rd.

TRUSTEES – Trustee Von Bergen provided generator options & costs along with material lists. Supervisor Lech & Road Commissioner had previously researched costs and grant options as well. Flagpole update, hoping to start this spring still waiting on BSA approval.

CEMETERY – 0 staking, 0 grave sales.

SUPERVISOR: GREEN STREET – Received \$3000 for remainder of May, all June, all July, & \$300 to August. GENERAL ASSISTANCE – 0 inquiries. ADMIN/BUILDING – Heavy snow caused snow stop bar to rip off near the road district, Road Commission was able to caulk off until the repair was made, replaced some screens on the faucets & installed 3 blinds. There will be a Trustee vacancy in May, the community room is back in use. The township office building mortgage is due for renewal in December 2021, there was a discussion on rates & terms, will investigate more.
