He reported that IDOT is responsible for the street marking on Route 26 and they will get them marked right away.

Supervisor Report: Supervisor Rick Swan said that ground on the new HiRISE Apartment building down in the Levee District should start in November, 2021. He also received numerous reports on how nice the Cemetery looking for Memorial Day. Thank to Joe and his crew!
