The release of the REVISED 2019 Laws and Duties Handbook is here! You have two options to purchase the book. You can log onto the TOI store and purchase the book (and other TOI publications) online or mail in your order with payment to the TOI office. Don't forget to order one for each of your board members!

With ALL online orders, you are required to initiate a purchase within the new Association Management Software system. After selecting your purchase and you are checking out, you are asked to log into your account. You can access this by your email address that we have on file with your membership. If you do not have an email address on file with our office, you are

asked to create an account with an email address. This address is used only for ordering purposes. We do not distribute email addresses to third party vendors under any circumstances unless authorized to do so. If you use the email address you have on file with us it will ask you for a PASSWORD. This password was emailed to everyone via the email address we had on file on as of January 7, 2020. Check your email for this password. You can contact the office if you have any questions.

It is my hope that you will embrace technology and this new process of purchasing publications and registering for events managed by the association. It provides member interaction and tracking to enhance the process by providing updated information for everyone.
