There was discussion on cemetery bid specs.

The septic was serviced, everything working properly, there is a spongebob sippy cup floating in the tank that was too deep to remove it should not cause issues unless tank becomes overfull. Also the Wiring for the lift station should be moved or redone when the pump needs replacing they are in a spot that shows signs of wear from the mower.
