Trustees Absent: David Sage.

Also present were Staff: Renee Gooderham, Chief Deputy Town Clerk; Joe Gibson, Township Supervisor, and Mike Ireland, Township Assessor.

Absent: Tracey Covert, Town Clerk.

Trustee Stockton opened the Public Hearing on the Amended 2012 - 2013 Fiscal Year Budget.

Joe Gibson, Township Supervisor, addressed the Board. He explained that Evergreen Cemetery was not included in 2012 - 2013 Fiscal Year Budget. He noted that Township has overseen the Cemetery since 2005 - 2006. This amendment aligns the Cemetery budget within the Township.

No one came forward to address the Board.

Trustee Mwilambwe questioned expenses and fund balance. Mr. Gibson stated that the fund balance was \$468,086 and the budgeted revenue was \$704,000. He anticipated the Cemetery having a fund balance of \$428,000 at the end of the year.

The Minutes of April 23, 2012 Regular Session were presented.

Motion by Trustee Fruin, seconded by Trustee Anderson that the reading of the Minutes April 23, 2012 Regular Session meeting be dispensed with and approved as presented.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, McDade, Stearns, Fazzini, Schmidt, Mwilambwe, Fruin, Anderson and Stockton.

Motion carried.

The audit for the General Town Fund and the General Assistance Fund April 2012.

Motion by Trustee Fruin, seconded by Trustee Anderson, to approve the audits as presented and place on file.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, McDade, Stearns, Fazzini, Schmidt, Mwilambwe, Fruin, Anderson and Stockton.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

The anticipated expenditures were presented.

Motion by Trustee Fruin, seconded by Trustee Anderson, to approve the anticipated expenditures.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, Schmidt, Fruin, Fazzini, McDade, Mwilambwe, Stearns, Anderson and Stockton.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

Joe Gibson, Township Supervisor, presented the Amended Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 – 2013 Budget Ordinance.

Trustee Stockton noted that the Public Hearing had been held.

Motion by Trustee Fruin, seconded by Trustee Anderson to approve the Amended FY 2012 – 2013 Budget and the Ordinance passed.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, Schmidt, Fruin, Fazzini, McDade, Mwilambwe, Stearns, Anderson and Stockton.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

The Ordinance for June 2012 Prevailing Rate of Wages was presented.

Mr. Gibson noted that the Ordinance included Evergreen Cemetery.

Motion by Trustee Fruin, seconded by Trustee Anderson to approve the June 2012 Prevailing Rate of Wages and the Ordinance passed.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, Schmidt, Fruin, Fazzini, McDade, Mwilambwe, Stearns, Anderson and Stockton.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

The Resolution to allow service credit (IMRF) for Military Service was presented.

Mr. Gibson stated that the Resolution mirrored the City of Bloomington. The cost was up front to the employee. The Township would have thirty (30) years to pay.

Trustee Fruin questioned the number of employees eligible. Mr. Gibson explained it was difficult to determine cost until an employee applies. Rates would be raised the .02% over

fifteen to thirty (15 - 30) years. He noted cost could vary depending on the employee's years of service and age.

Trustee Fruin questioned the number of military service years allowed. Mr. Gibson responded four (4) years.

Motion by Trustee Fruin, seconded by Trustee Anderson that the Resolution be adopted.

Ayes: Trustees Purcell, Schmidt, Fruin, Fazzini, McDade, Mwilambwe, Stearns, Anderson and Stockton.

Nays: None.

Motion carried.

Joe Gibson, Township Supervisor, addressed the Board. A written report had been prepared. He addressed the number of General Assistance (GA) cases for April 2012 which totaled 186 this was increase of three (3) from last year. Township participates were enrolled in Community Service, Drug Court, GED Classes and Skills for Success at Heartland Community College. Miller Park Zoo had hired a recipient.

Mike Ireland, Township Assessor, addressed the Board. He had prepared a written report. He provided information on website usage. Usage increased during fall assessment and first quarter of the year. The website averaged approximately 10,000 - 12,000 hits. It would take a full time employee to provide the information.

Property assessments for 2012 will be posted. The web site states the values are subject to change prior to finalization. There were potentially 900 residential properties that could receive new assessments this summer.

Trustee Stockton opened the meeting to Public Comment. No one came forward to address the Board.

Motion by Trustee Anderson, seconded by Trustee Purcell to adjourn. Time: 6:57 p.m.

As part of your funding of our Pharmacy Tech position, please accept this as our mid-year report.

Our part-time pharmacy technician, Leigh Hunt, began at the end of January 2011 and this position continues to show its value to clinic services. Because we now have a consistent person filling medications on a regular basis, the few medication errors we had previously have been eliminated completely. In addition, the pharmacy technician has designed a monitoring system that allows us to flag patients who continue to receive medications, but have not had an up-to-date appointment, have not completed recommended lab work, and/or have not provided updated income documentation. This program was implemented in Fall 2011.

Using this system, clinic staff notifies patients who are in need of one or more of the following: scheduling an appointment, completing lab work and/or providing necessary income verification. Following the notification, clinic staff and/or volunteers work with the patients to assist them in completing these tasks and becoming compliant with their medical recommendations. As of this point, we have tracked 140 total patients who were non-compliant in at least one of the areas listed above. To date, of those 140 non-compliant patients, only 38 remain non-compliant and that number decreases on a weekly basis. This increased follow-up and monitoring of patient status will lead to better health outcomes for our patients. Every staff member is positively affected by this process that Ms. Hunt initiates. By ensuring compliance in those four areas, the practitioners can be assured that necessary lab work has been completed, making the patient visits much more meaningful. Our IDAP Coordinator's work is made much more efficient because the proof of income is in the charts allowing the medications to be ordered in the timeliest manner. And lastly, with Ms. Hunt monitoring patient appointments, our patients are being seen more frequently, and new studies have shown that more frequent visits are directly related to positive health incomes.

In the past, we had designated times where patients were to come and pick up their medications. This system worked, but those designated times were not always the most convenient for our patients who may have transportation issues or work schedules that kept them busy during out pick-up times. By having Ms. Hunt here, we have eliminated these designated times and now patients are able to come anytime during business hours to obtain their medications. Small measures like this continue to remove those hurdles that our patients face in managing their health care, but again, without our part-time pharmacy tech, this would not have been an option for us. Our dispensary continues to be a key piece in what we do, and it remains our biggest service in pure numbers. From July 1, 2011 through May 23, 2012, 19,566 have been dispensed by our pharmacy tech.

We are asking for another small increase for this position for Fall 2012. Two major things have occurred which cause us to again revisit this position's salary. OSF Healthcare again looked at their salary ranges for specific positions and the pharmacy technician was grossly underestimated. Given their recommendations on national and state salary comparisons, we would like to increase our hourly scale for our pharmacy technician. With her experience, we are suggesting increasing her hourly rate to \$11.47. During this fiscal year, we also amended our OSF leased employee agreement for our benefits costs. Through an updated analysis, we found our benefits costs are currently 28% of salaries where we were previously paying 32%. This reduction in benefits payments allows us to put more into the pharmacy technician positions' hourly pay. The table below outlines the current funding and our proposal for an increase in support for our pharmacy technician position.
