

**Minutes – Board of Town Trustees
November 20, 2014**

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES met at the Robinson Township Office at 6:00 p.m. November 20, 2014.

The following official business was transacted. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Larry McCoy.

Mr. McCoy then asked for the roll call.

The Pledge of Allegiance had been recited at the Road and Bridge Tax Levy Hearing.

Persons from the public attending the meeting were as follows: Becky Taylor, Janie Thackrey, Gary Wilson, and Matthew Wilson.

Item 4, Mr. McCoy asked for public comments. There were none.

Item 5, Approval of minutes of previous meeting. He asked if the trustees had any questions or changes concerning the minutes of the October 16, 2014 regular monthly board meeting. There being none, Greg Wolfe made the motion, seconded by Lori Hodge, to approve the minutes for the meeting as written. Motion carried with vote as follows: Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Under Item 6A, the Supervisor's report, Mr. McCoy read the beginning and ending balances for the Total Town Money Market, Total Road and Bridge Money Market, and General Assistance Money Market funds. He concluded by stating that the interest rate on the Certificates of Deposits at First Robinson Savings Bank has remained the same. He noted the intergovernmental GA cases. He asked for questions. There being none, he mentioned that Stan Mullins asked about decorating the park in the cemetery. Mr. McCoy asked the trustees if they had an opinion about it. After discussion, the trustees didn't think it was necessary or appropriate. Mr. McCoy then asked for the Highway Commissioner's Report.

Highway Commissioner's Report, Item 6B. Mr. Lachenmayr said the crew has gotten the equipment ready for snow plowing, and the County was able to find salt. The bins are full, but the price for salt had increased from \$65.00 to \$150.00 per ton. Snow plows are on as are the brine tank and salt spreader. The crew has been trimming brush and waiting to see what winter brings.

Item 6C, Assessor's Report. Mrs. Roberts said she didn't have a lot to report at this time, but noted several houses and other buildings being built.

Item 7A, Continued Business, Adoption of 2014 Town Tax Levy collectible in 2015. Mr. McCoy told the trustees that the levy was left the same as the previous year. He asked if there were questions or discussion, then called for a motion to adopt said Town Tax Levy. Greg Wolfe made the motion and Lori Hodge seconded. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; Shirley Berry-yes.

Item 7B, Continued Business, Adoption of the 2014 Road Tax Levy collectible in 2015. Pat Richards made the motion to adopt the 2014 Road Tax Levy collectible in 2015. Shirley Berry seconded the motion which carried with vote as follows: Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes.

Item 8A, Other Business: Lori Hodge moved to approve payment of Town, G.A., and Payroll bills. Greg Wolfe seconded the motion. Motion carried with vote as follows: Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes.

Item 8B, Shirley Berry made a motion to pay the Road District bills. Pat Richards seconded the motion. Motion carried with vote as follows: Larry McCoy-yes; Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes.

Item 8C: Lori Hodge made a motion, seconded by Greg Wolfe, to pre-approve payment of elected officials for the time period of November 21, 2014, through December 18, 2014. Motion carried with vote as follows: Shirley Berry-yes; Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge-yes; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes.

Item 9: Shirley Berry made a motion, seconded by Lori Hodge, to pay per diem. Motion carried with vote as follows: Pat Richards-yes; Lori Hodge; Greg Wolfe-yes; Larry McCoy-yes; and Shirley Berry-yes.

Item 10: Adjourn Meeting: Motion was made by Shirley Berry and seconded by Pat Richards to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried with all in favor voting aye. Meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m.
