

Annual Town Meeting of Pin Oak Township
3700 Tosovsky Lane, Edwardsville, IL 62025
April 8, 2014 - 7:30 p.m. - Minutes

1. Meeting was called to order by Kathy Long, Clerk.
2. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. Nominations for Moderator of Annual Town Meeting were requested:
Seth Joy nominated Brad Maxwell. No other nominations were submitted.
David Peverly made a motion to elect Brad Maxwell as Moderator. Fred Decker seconded. A majority vote by registered voters in attendance approved the motion.
4. Moderator Oath of Office was given to Brad Maxwell by Kathy Long, Clerk.
“I do solemnly swear that I will faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of moderator at this Town Meeting, so help me God”.
5. Minutes from April 16, 2013 Annual Town Meeting were read by clerk. Seth Joy made a motion to approve the minutes from 2013. Dennis Mueller seconded. Hearing no objections, 2013 Annual Town Meeting minutes were approved.
6. Annual Financial Statement of Township Supervisor was read by the clerk.
Dennis Mueller made a motion to accept the Annual Financial statement as submitted. David Peverly seconded. Hearing no opposition, the motion was approved.
7. Business of Pin Oak Township to be considered and discussed:
 - 2014 – 2015 Township Budget and Road District Budgets were discussed.
No questions or concerns followed. Budgets to remain posted for review by the public.
 - Discussion of a name for the new Silver Creek Bridge was held. Robert Helms has received a note from the County and they have tentatively suggested Chamberlain Bridge. John Chamberlain is a longtime resident in the area. Bob has not discussed the bridge name with John C. as of yet. Arnold Buescher suggested naming the bridge after the Tallier Family if Chamberlain does not approve the bridge being named after his family. Seth made a motion to proceed with Chamberlain Bridge. Tim Tosovsky seconded. Motion approved.

Dennis Mueller made the motion to proceed with Tallier if Mr. Chamberlain does not approve having the bridge named after his family. Tim Tosovsky seconded. Second motion approved.

- Pin Oak Township Website Update – Seth Joy updated attendees on our new website with calendar capabilities. Hopefully within the next two weeks the old TOI website will link to the new website. www.pinoaktownship.com Seth provided a demonstration of the website and information available.
- Pin Oak Township Property Update – Robert Helms stated that not much is happening at this time. Gene Kohlmiller commented on the water damage in the Assessor’s office due to pipes bursting because of a furnace shut down. Some damage to the outside of the building has been repaired. Maintenance and cleaning options were discussed. Jack Mitchell discussed the septic system and grease trap issues were being addressed. A grease trap clean out will be installed.
- Arnold Buescher asked if the board was going to continue with payment of the Moderator. Yes, a stipend of \$25.00 will be paid to the Moderator for their service at the Annual Town Meeting.

8. No other public comments were heard.

9. Robert Helms made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:27 p.m. Jack Mitchell seconded. Hearing no opposition, meeting was adjourned.
