This is free-of-charge to residents of the township and the surrounding community. Materials to be recycled may be dropped-off at the Township Building from 9am to 1pm. The Township Building is located at 9327 239th Street (the corner of 239th Street and Hillsdale Road). A partial list of things that can be dropped off is below but basically if it has a cord on it, metal in it, or a motor on it Cowboy's will accept it. You may call them at 309-797-1046 or 309-269-9956 if you wish to ask them about a specific item.

Accepted items:

Car batteries, Aluminum cans
Pots and Pans, Jewelry,
All computer items, copy machines,
Fax machines, monitors, PCs,
Computer mice, keyboards,
walkie-talkies, cell phones, house phones,
CB radios, stereos, toasters, coffee pots,
power scooters, kid's scooters, bikes of all kinds,
hair dryers, curling iron's, back massagers,
police scanners, VCR's, DVD players,
electric or regular wheel chairs,
electric or regular hospital beds,
electric recliners, lamps of all kinds,
all electric wiring such as house wiring,
Christmas lights, drop cords,
all metal plumbing pipes, metal sinks,
filing cabinets, BBQ grills, metal lawn furniture,
clocks, electric heaters, metal toys of all kinds,
light fixtures, ceiling fans, heater ducts and
grates,
tractors, all kinds of farm machinery,
metal fencing,
air conditioners, car radiators, power washers,
metal house doors and windows,

tv's, tools of all kinds,
car rims, air compressors,
anything aluminum, copper, brass,
appliances such as washers, dryers, stoves,
refrigerators, hot water heaters,
dish washers, trash compactors,
water softeners, microwaves, freezers,
furnaces,
lift chairs for stairs,
golf carts, stainless steel sinks,
all restaurant equipment,
pizza ovens, restaurant ovens,
walk-in coolers, floor jacks,
chain hoists, tool boxes,
all electronic games such as
sega, Nintendo, playstation, Xboxes, etc.
car motors and transmissions (must be out of
car)
yard tools such as hedge trimmers,
weed eaters, hand tools,
metal dishes, camp stoves,
lawnmowers – riding or push,
tires of any kind (there may be a \$5.00 charge
for some tires)
